




### **August 2021 Quilt Show**



## CHQ Quilting Tips



### Quick Quilting tips from the Newsletter Editor:

- Have you tried Free Motion Quilting (FMQ)
  - o Practice, Practice, Practice. I practice doodling while watching T.V., in Staff Meetings, while on the phone, and on my Yahtzee Pad while my husband beats me at all the games.
  - Look for inspiration on YouTube, Books, Local Classes, On-Line Classes, floors, paper towels, zentangle coloring books, Pinterest...
  - Use Community Quilts to practice your actual quilting
  - O Use Plexiglass with painter's tape around it (so you don't mark your quilt) and put it on your quilt and use a wet erase marker and practice different designs on your quilt, practice on top of a book or printed out page so you gain memory muscles, practice and learn how to make the design one continuous line. (Thanks Penny for the Plexiglass TIP)
  - Play with different colors and types of thread. What I use on my domestic machine may not be what I use on my sit down longarm.
  - o Encourage each other to try...

\*Cheyenne Police Department 307-637-6524

\*National Credit Bureaus – Experian, Transunion and Equifax. Place a freeze on your credit history. The thief can't set up new accounts, make purchases, etc without your approval. You can remove the freeze if necessary.

\*Federal Trade Commission - report Identity Theft www.identitytheft.gov

1-877-438-4338

\*Change all passwords affected. You can look on your browser and see which have been compromised. Best to change to obscure passwords and keep a record off your computer. Keeping them stored on a USB stick is a safe way to keep them.

- \*Remove any Credit Card or bank information from all accounts. Change the cards if necessary. Put spending limits on any transactions over the internet or by phone. You must be contacted to approve the expenditure.
- \*Monitor your transactions to make sure they are yours and not the hacker.
- \*Credit card transactions are insured and you can report the loss and not be held responsible. Debit cards are NOT insured.
- \*Norton/Lifelock. Install on your computer. Protection against hackers. Lifelock insures for \$1,000,000.00
- \*AARP Fraud Watch Network 877-908-3360
