She is in great condition and well taken care of; I am just upgrading. Currently in for routine maintenance, which is only required every 30 million stitches (approximately 5-8 years.)

Includes two stitch regulators, manual mode for small, dense quilting and basting modes, an on-board bobbin winder and threading at the front of the machine. Cabinet extends from 45" to 77".

Extras, in addition to the suspension system, include the 96 foot for ruler work, horizontal spool pin, pin point laser light and extra lighting for intense, close up quilting.

Used for everything from general quilting to art quilts and award-winning quilts. You can even add binding with the Q20! The Q20 is easy to maintain and smooth running. It's a great machine!

Machine is heavy and bolted into the cabinet so it's better to move it once before relocating. Purchaser responsible for relocation but we would be glad to assist. The time has come to take up the next **QUILT CHALLENGE!**

I think there is a lot of possibility in this year's task, so be sure to bring \$10 to the quilt show especially for this year's challenge packet.

Quick Quilting tips from the Newsletter Editor:

Quilting during the summer

- Use an alternative to the traditional batting such as another piece of fabric vs batting or no batting at all. Flannel could be used on the back of a quilt with no batting.
- Make lots of quilt tops and save the quilting for winter.
- Make smaller quilts or wall art quilts so that you do not get wrapped in a heavy quilt while quilting.
- Join a quilt along, sign up for retreats that are not located in the heat.
 - Give your machine(s) some love and get their yearly maintenance complete before the holiday season.

Start those holiday gifts early!!!




Ugly Fat Quarter Christmas Exchange Challenge

We had **24** members step up to participate in our fun-filled Ugly Fat Quarter Christmas exchange challenge project. Each fat quarter was placed in a numbered bag along with a notion. We tracked the numbered bags by the donor quilters name. Bags were drawn at the July meeting where we tracked which numbered bag the quilter drew to ensure that they did not draw their own. **Members participating are required to make a project**, be it a table runner, a table topper, a bag/purse, a lap quilt, a wall hanging, a scissor case, a mug rug, or whatever. **The majority of the fat quarter and the notion** <u>must</u> be used in the final project.

Keep your project confidential for the final reveal. Finished projects are to be wrapped, the number from the bag added as a gift tag, and brought to the December 6, 2021, meeting where we reveal the last "fun factor" to this challenge.




