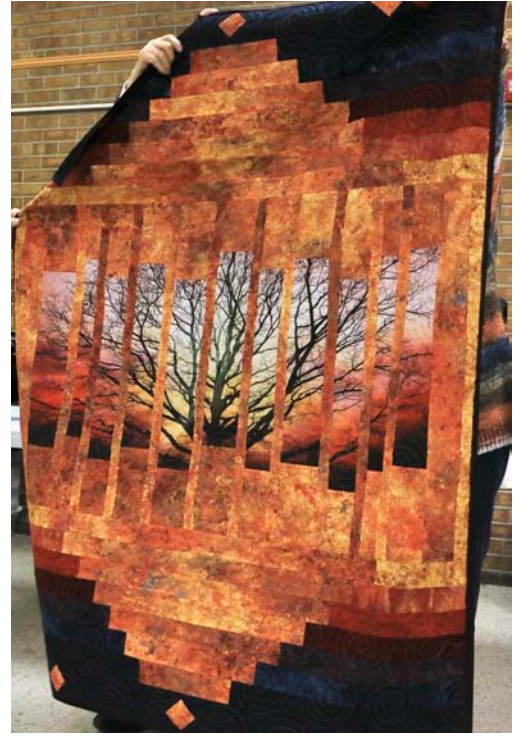

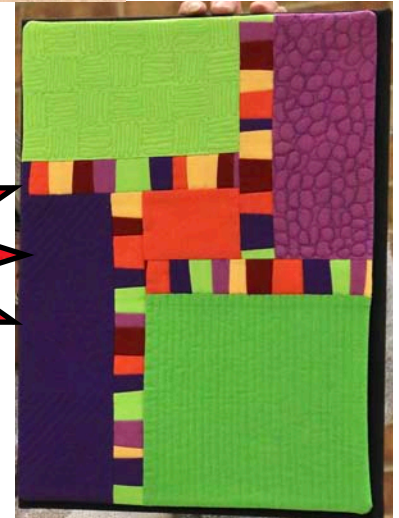

# Stash Challenge

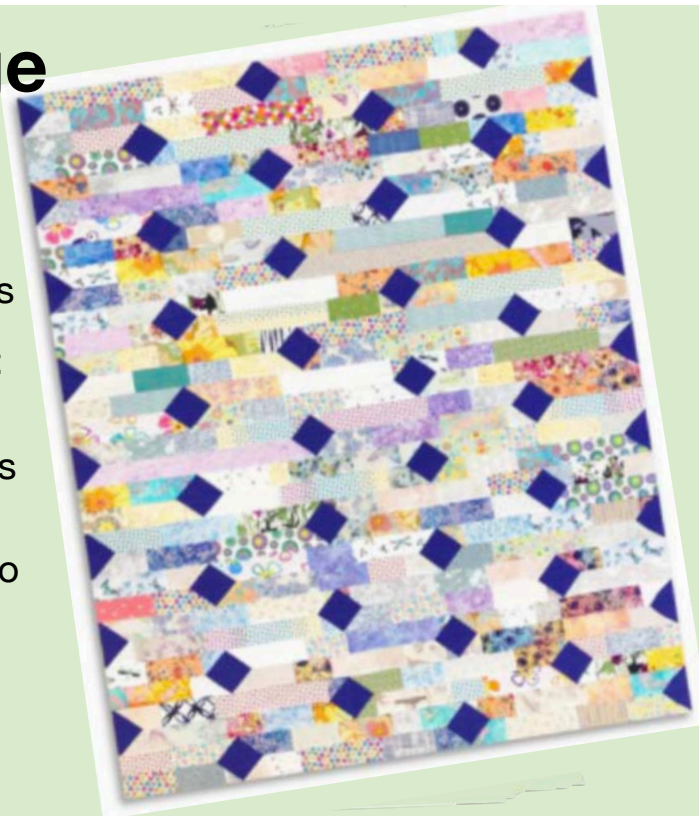
Start the new year fresh by participating in this challenge.

She brought many antique RedWork Quilts to share as well as her vast knowledge on the subject!





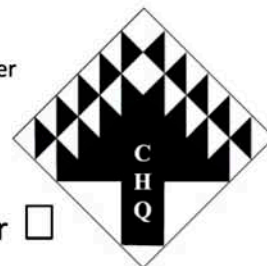
