Stash Challenge

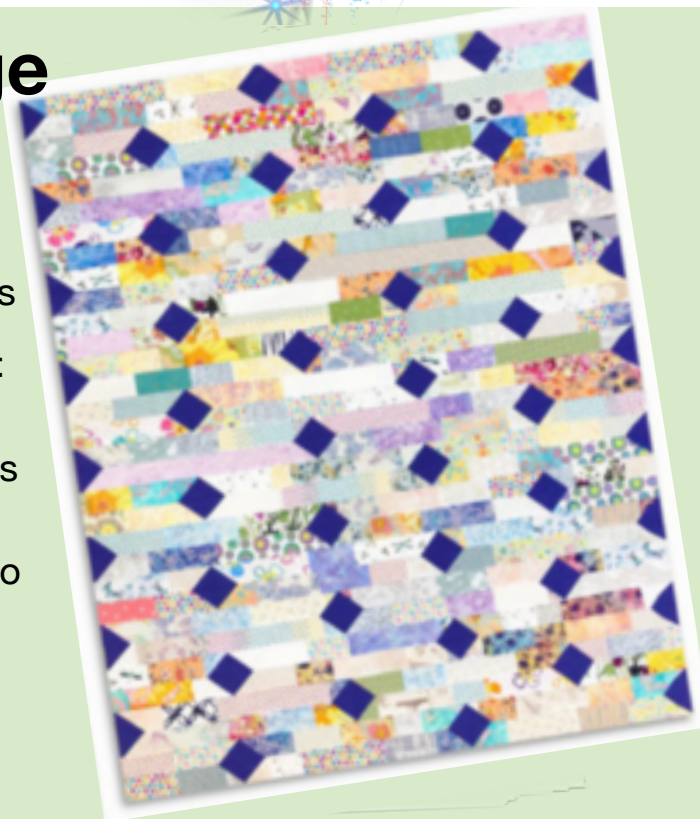
Start the new year fresh by
