The class is a technique class focusing on curved piecing. The kit will be for a pillow top using the technique Robbin has used for her quilt pattern.


The class will be held on Saturday August 20, 2022 at Little Bear from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.


Curved Piecing Class with Robbin Flockhart


