About the CHQ 2011 Quilt Show:

- 1. Anyone can **enter up to 3 quilts** any size that have not been exhibited in a past CHQ show. There are no entry fees for CHQ members. The non-CHQ members' entry fee is \$5 per quilt or they may choose to join the guild for \$20, good for the remainder of the current membership year and the 2011-12 year beginning Sept. 1.
- 2. All quilt entries are eligible for judging by trained judges from the Colorado Quilting Council. A one-page critique will be attached to the quilt entry when it is released at the end of the show. The \$5 per quilt judging fee will be put into a purse for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place Judge's Choice awards.
- 3. Any quilt entry may be listed **for sale** in the program and on the quilt's display tag. Quilts must be paid for in full and no holds will be honored. CHQ will collect payment from the buyer and deliver the quilt to the buyer at the end of the show. Sellers should expect a check for 80 percent of the sale price shortly after the show. CHQ retains a 20 percent commission for advertising & exhibiting costs.
- 4. All quilts must have a **hanging sleeve** attached made from a 4-inch fabric tube. For directions, please contact Barb, 307-634-0463, bgorges4@msn.com.
- All quilts entered must have a complete entry form with fees submitted by Aug. 15 to Carole Gardner at either a CHQ meeting or by mail to her: 5104 Windmill, Chevenne, WY 82009, 307-634-9346.
- 6. All quilts must be delivered in a cloth bag or pillow case identified with the entrant's name and phone number and the quilt folded and inserted so as to show the entry form Quilt Identification Tag pinned to the lower right corner of the back of the quilt. - 7. Exhibit space at the show is limited. Quilts will be assigned space in the order in which registration is received until all space is filled. If there is no room for your quilt, we will try to notify you before you deliver it and we will return all fees.
