October 7 Program - Lea McComas - Pictorial Quilt Primer

Lea McComas began sewing at age 6 and quilting at 16. She is an accomplished knitter who spins and dyes her own yarn. Living abroad in the 1990's, she studied carpet weaving in Turkey and fabric dying in Japan. Upon her return to the United States in 2001, she began a study of classic European art, and developed a keen interest in portrait and figurative art. Her current techniques and compositions are a synthesis of these passions as she uses textiles to create realistic pictorial works.

Lea's artwork has been highlighted in a variety of online and print publications such as Quilting Arts Magazine and TV, and TheQuiltShow.com. Her work has been featured in many national and international exhibitions, and has won numerous awards including the Masters Award for Thread Artistry at IQF Houston in 2014 and 2019.

She is a Juried Artist Member of SAQA, the founder and curator of the Border Wall Quilt Project, and recently completed the epic art quilt, Women's Work for exhibition at the Clinton Presidential Library. It features 57 women who have fought for equality and the right to vote.

Lea shares the knowledge and techniques behind her award-winning quilts through her articles, lectures, workshops, and in her books, Thread Painted Portraits, and Women's Work.



Marla Marx is from Scottsbluff, Nebraska and came to our club to share her love of quilting and using RULERS!!!

She showed us many Deb Heatherly Rulers, and others by Brenda Henning, Linda McGhee, and Deb Tucker. I think I got them all. Her favorite rulers have several size options on them. Marla loves to figure out ways to make the piecing process of a quilt design easier or more efficient.

She gave us several tips. 1. Use a Boston Clip to keep the instructions and the ruler together.

2. When applying Piping - Move needle to right one step further than you think

it should be when basting the piping. This will keep your basting out of sight when you do the final seams. (I hope I got this right.).

3. Cut scallops after quilting.
